1.Introduction

We are happy to announce that we can let this competition take place in a COVID-responsible way.

To be able to keep it safe we will take the necessary measures. Therefore, as you will see in this announcement, there will be some differences in the organisation of the competition.

No changes are expected. However, depending on the evolution of the instructions regarding Covid 19, modifications to the organization of the competition can be made. In this case, the organizing committee will communicate as fast as possible.

This protocol is specific to the Starclass from Oct 29 2021 till Oct 31st 2021, organised at Sport Vlaanderen Hasselt.

It is the sole responsibility of everyone who will be at this event to follow the regulations of this event and the regulations of the government.

Failure to follow these rules will mean that the skater involved will be disqualified and both the offender and the skater will have to leave the Sport Vlaanderen property immediately.

During the event, the CoronSafe Team will be supported by stewards who will help raise awareness, monitor compliance with the measures and correct shortages.





3. Measures

The experience and well-being of the participants was central to the decisions about the measures taken.

By separating the different types of attendees, we are able to limit other restrictions (such as face masks, social distancing, testing, ...).

1. Corona certificate

Thanks to the measures taken, there is NO NEED for testing, nor to prove Corona certification for visitors. For them, a face mask is obligated!

For accredited persons it is mandatory to prove Covid Safe Ticket (CST), see below.

2. Accreditations

There will be a reception desk where accreditations will be handed out and CST will be checked. This is only for undermentioned groups.

Visitors and spectators are not eligible for an accreditation and are therefore not allowed in other zones than assigned to them (see map).

There will be accreditations for following groups:

- Skaters
- Team leaders
- Coach
- o Official
- Volunteer
- Organisation
- o First-aid






3. Zoning

The ice rink will be splitted into different zones (with capacity levels).

- Skaters, team leaders and coach area
 Spectators and visitors are not allowed in this zone!
 It is mandatory to prove Covid Safe Ticket (CST), to be allowed. Face mask is not mandatory!
 Skaters can only prepare / change clothes in this area, it is not allowed to do this in the spectator area.
- Official area
 Only officials and organisation are allowed in this zone!
 It is mandatory to prove Covid Safe Ticket (CST), to be allowed.
- Spectator area
 Everyone is allowed in this area to watch the competition.
 Face mask is mandatory!
 It is not allowed to prepare / change clothes in this zone!
- Sportbar Kapermolen
 Sportbar Kapermolen is on 1th floor, with a view at the ice rink.







4. Coaches & team leaders

The number of attendees will be limited as much as possible.

That is why we also limit the number of team leaders and coaches in the assigned area:

1 coach/club and 1 teamleader/club

Change of coach/team leader during the event is allowed as long as they have proved Covid Safe Ticket (CST).
